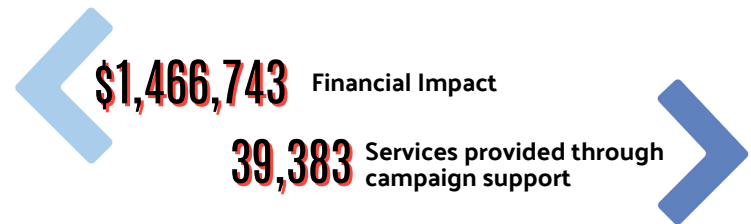
Grant Support
